



Speaking Topics

Come to the Table:

This talk invites listeners to see God in a fresh and deeply personal way—not only through familiar attributes, but as a loving Host who prepares a place for them at His table. Through story, Scripture, and personal experience, it illustrates how God extends an intentional, grace-filled invitation to each of us, regardless of our past or present circumstances. Using the example of Mephibosheth, it highlights God’s surprising kindness, pursuit, and restoration, reminding us that we are welcomed as honored guests—and even family. Ultimately, the message calls listeners to accept that invitation, step out of isolation or unworthiness, and experience the fullness of life and fellowship God has prepared.

Feast at the Table:

This talk explores what it means to “feast with God” in our daily lives, emphasizing that true spiritual nourishment comes from engaging deeply with His Word and prayer. It highlights how feasting on Scripture helps us know God personally, understand His love, and live out our unique purpose. Through biblical examples and personal stories, it shows that even in busy or difficult seasons, time with God brings strength, peace, and renewed perspective. Ultimately, the message encourages believers to intentionally create rhythms of connection with God—no matter how simple or short—and to accept His invitation to meet with Him daily.

Pass the Plate:

This talk encourages believers to “pass the plate” by living lives of invitation, reflecting God’s heart as a gracious Host who welcomes all to His table. It emphasizes that hospitality is not about perfection or performance, but about being led by the Holy Spirit to love, serve, and include others—whether in our homes, daily routines, or communities.

Through practical ideas and personal stories, it shows that every season offers unique opportunities to extend God's love, from caring for family to reaching the marginalized. Ultimately, the message calls listeners to intentionally invite others into relationship with God, trusting Him to guide and empower their efforts.

Securely Seated at God's Glorious Table:

This closing talk summarizes the weekend's message, reminding listeners that God lovingly invites them to take their seat at His table, feast on His Word, and live as hosts who extend that invitation to others. It emphasizes that through Jesus, the ultimate Bridegroom, believers are welcomed into an eternal relationship culminating in the future "Marriage Supper of the Lamb." The message encourages participants to abide in Christ, trust His Spirit to guide their lives, and respond to His invitation with both faith and action. Ultimately, it calls them to leave transformed—secure in their place at God's table and ready to share His love with others.

Made to Flourish:

This talk uses the metaphor of a garden to explain that people are created by God to flourish through a relationship with Him. It emphasizes that Jesus is the way to restoration and growth, and that flourishing comes from abiding in Him daily, being nourished by His word, and remaining connected to a community of believers. The speakers also highlight that seasons of hardship or "dormancy" can still produce deep spiritual growth. Ultimately, a flourishing life is one that reflects God's love outwardly, serving others and spreading His goodness in the world.
