



Statement of Faith

We believe the Bible—both the Old and New Testaments—is the inspired Word of God, true and without error in its original writings. It is the final authority for what we believe and how we live, and it reveals to the world God’s heart and His love.

We believe God is the one sovereign Creator of all things. He is eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

We believe in the Lord Jesus Christ—fully God—born of a virgin, sinless in life, and mighty in works. We believe in His sacrificial and atoning death through His shed blood, His bodily resurrection, His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and His promised return in power and glory.
